











MATCHING PAIRS







Make & Bake Gingerbread Sinoceratops

Follow the step-by-step instructions below to make your own tasty Gingerbread Sinoceratops. Have fun decorating them with icing, sprinkles and your favourite sweets.

Makes About 6-10 (Depending On Cutter Size Used)
Preparation Time: 30 Mins • Baking Time 15 Mins

STEP 1

Pre-heat the oven to 180C/Gas 4. Put the flour, butter, ginger, cinnamon and bicarbonate of soda in a mixing bowl. Mix it all together with your fingertips until crumbly. Next add the egg, sugar and syrup and keep mixing until it's a nice firm pastry mix.

STEP 2


Using a rolling pin, roll the pastry so it's about 5mm thick. Make sure the surface and rolling pin are well dusted in flour to avoid it sticking.

STEP 3

Place your cut out Gingerbread Sinoceratops on a greased or non-stick baking tray and place in the middle of the pre-heated oven.

Bake for about 15 minutes until golden brown. Cooking times may vary depending on your oven.

INGREDIENTS

350g plain flour

- 100g butter
- 5 1/2 teaspoons ground ginger
- 1 1/2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon bicarbonate soda
- 175g light brown soft sugar
- 4 tablespoons golden syrup
- 1 medium egg

STEP 4

Once your Gingerbread Sinoceratops are baked, carefully remove from the oven and allow to cool. Once cooled, have fun spending time decorating them with icing, sprinkles and your

favourite sweets.

Note:

You will need a Sinoceratops/Triceratops shaped pastry cutter, or you can cut out and use the guide we have included above. You can use this as a template for cutting your Gingerbread Sinoceratops by simply laying it on the dough and carefully cutting around the edges.

Please ask a parent/guardian permission and help with the pastry cutting and using the oven.
